1. Describe in 100 words or less, the nature of your project. The description will be in a booklet KMB prints so that others may know about your nomination.
2. When did the project begin? Is it completed? Ongoing?
3. How many people were involved with the project? Paid personnel or volunteers?
4. How has the community reacted to the project? Did it fill a need?

Rules and Conditions:

Only exterior projects will be considered. A private residence is not eligible. The project must be in Michigan and not previously nominated for a KMB Award. Nominations must be accompanied by supporting materials. Both neatness and content count. Loose photos will not be accepted. Enclose all materials, including this form in a folder. KMB will not accept 3-ring notebooks. Notebooks or folders from other competitions will not be accepted. All nominations will be accepted at the discretion of the judges when all of the above conditions have been met. The contact person will receive notice that the nomination has been received by KMB. Winners will be notified with information about the **KMB Award Program, scheduled for October 15, 2010 in Kalamazoo, Michigan.**
